Rep. Jamie Comer Supports Our Reading Recovery Program

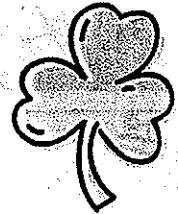
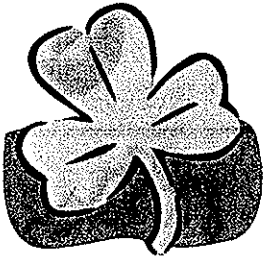
